



## **Nuvau Minerals Corp.**

Nuvau Minerals Inc., recently listed on the TSXV under the symbol NMC, is leveraging the strategic acquisition of the one of the largest property packages in one of the most prolific mining camps in Canada. Located in the northern Abitibi Greenstone belt in the province of Quebec, Nuvau's copper-zinc Matagami Mining Camp is in the heart of a region that boasts a history of significant mineral endowment.
